

## Texas Ally Seeking Support for Venezuelan Victims' Justice & Urgent Meeting with Secretary Rubio

Dear Senator Scott,

As a Florida senator and longtime ally of Secretary Marco Rubio on Venezuela policy, I urge your support for Dr. Leroy Garrett's pro se fight for a Qualified Settlement Fund (QSF) benefiting ~23,000 survivors of the "Petroleum Holocaust" (Chavista purges, Tascón List abuses since 2002-2003).

Dr. Garrett (Katy, TX) faces judicial hurdles in the Delaware Citgo sale (No. 17-mc-00151-LPS; access restricted D.I. 2644, February 10, 2026) and OFAC petitions (Docket OFAC-2025-CITGO-SALE) urging humanitarian carve-outs amid U.S.-controlled revenues. His February 20, 2026 OFAC alert on the amnesty law (February 19) highlights impunity risks—aligning with your calls for accountability.

Please advocate for Dr. Garrett's QSF in sanctions/judicial processes and facilitate an ASAP meeting with Secretary Rubio to discuss carve-outs and a truth commission—before asset distributions overlook victims.
